## **Rokita: “Resolution of Disapproval is the End Result of a Bad Washington Deal”**

Washington, DC – Today Rep. Todd Rokita voted for the Resolution of Disapproval for the debt ceiling increase authorized in the Budget Control Act of 2011 over the summer and issued the following statement:

*“I voted for today’s Resolution of Disapproval for the debt ceiling increase, because we cannot continue to pile trillions in debt on the backs of our children and grandchildren. Unfortunately, today’s vote was little more than a symbolic action, and in no way a victory. The Resolution of Disapproval is the end result of a bad Washington deal that passed over my objection last year. The cost of that deal was another \$2.5 trillion in debt and no new reforms to stop our out-of-control spending and balance our budget. I will continue working for real spending cuts, for action to address the mandatory spending programs driving our debt, and to ensure a future of opportunity and economic liberty for our children and grandchildren.”*
