Rokita Statement on 39th Annual March for Life

Washington, DC – Today Rep. Todd Rokita praised the March for Life and expressed his support for the pro-life movement:

“While the anniversary of Roe v. Wade is a somber occasion, each year I am inspired by the March for Life. It is an opportunity for hundreds of thousands to make their voice heard in Washington, DC and to rededicate themselves to protecting innocent human life.
